Activity

- Do you think your salon stocks the right amount of product , too little or too much



Activity

If a stylist mixed up 5% more tint than they needed for each colour client, over 20 clients a whole tube of tint has been wasted

 $(5\% \times 20 = 100\% - a \text{ full tube})$

1. If in one week, six salons stylist wasted 5% of tint, and carried out a total of 50 colour services- how many tubes of tint have been wasted?

Like other types of **asthma**, it is characterized by **airway** inflammation, reversible airways obstruction, and bronchospasm, but it is caused by something in the workplace environment. **Symptoms** include shortness of breath, tightness of the chest, nasal irritation, coughing and wheezing

What causes asthma, respiratory issues

Ammonia in colour

Phenylenediamine (PPD)

Hydrogen peroxide

Sodium hydroxide

How to prevent asthma, respiratory issues
